Subject: New Developments in Faculty Affairs

The Office of the Provost, Faculty Affairs is pleased to announce plans for *Interfolio*, a new faculty information system that replaces older systems and improves how we recruit and appoint faculty. The *Interfolio* implementation is coordinated with the <u>Human Capital Management initiative</u> to improve how Penn manages the broad range of human resources, payroll, and related processes.

There are three *Interfolio* modules being implemented this year:

- <u>Dossier</u> was made available to all Faculty on March 1, 2019. <u>Dossier</u> is <u>Interfolio</u>'s online platform for academics to use to collect and curate scholarly materials, request and receive confidential letters of recommendation, and prepare for upcoming evaluations.
- The Faculty Search (FS) module, a faculty recruitment tool, will be available to all Schools on June 17, 2019. Faculty serving on search committees will use FS to review and evaluate applications online.
- The *Review-Promotion-Tenure (RPT)* module, which will replace parts of the University's homegrown *Faculty Information System (FIS)*, will be available to all Schools on August 1, 2019. *RPT* streamlines the collection of review materials and approval workflows for appointment, reappointment and promotion cases.
