Funding: for stipend, tuition, travel and research supplies for 1-2 years

- Predoctoral trainees: Engineering PhD students who have completed their course work
- Postdoctoral trainees: MD clinical fellows (preferably)
- Trainees must be US citizens or resident aliens (green card holders)

Goal: to train predoctoral engineering students and physician postdoctoral fellows in neuroengineering and its clinical translation, **in areas such as device**

development, neuro-stimulation, machine learning, algorithm development, cloud computing, nanotechnology and materials science
