We are pleased to announce a request for applications for physicians who are enrolled in a post-graduate training program and are interested in improving health or healthcare equity for populations served by the Penn Medicine or CHOP healthcare system. The selected candidate will receive a full tuition scholarship to complete a Certificate in Healthcare Quality & Safety at the Perelman School of Medicine, University of Pennsylvania. While completing graduate-level coursework and receiving mentorship from QI and equity experts, the candidate will design and complete an equity improvement project.

Candidates will begin August 30, 2022 and complete the certificate program in one or two years.
