

CEET Pilot Project Program Summer 2022 - Call for Applications

The <u>Center of Excellence in Environmental Toxicology (CEET)</u> is currently accepting applications for the following four different types of pilot project opportunities.

Applications are due Friday, July 29, 2022.

Focused Research Award: Applicants can request up to \$50,000 for one year. Applications related to the following CEET thematic areas are currently being accepted:

- Air Pollution and Lung Health
- Environmental Exposures and Cancer
- Windows-of-Susceptibility
- Environmental Neuroscience

<u>Mentored Scientist Transition Award</u>: Provides up to \$50,000 per year in salary support to allow a senior postdoctoral researcher or clinical fellow establish independence in environmental health sciences.

<u>Opportunity Award</u>: Applications proposing innovative environmental health or toxicology research projects are encouraged. Applicants can request up to \$50,000 for one year.

Rapid Response Awards:

Request to Obtain Needed Preliminary Data - Provides up to \$10,000 to obtain needed preliminary data to support a revised grant application to the NIH or other agency.

Environmental Justice Rapid Pilot Project - Provides up to \$10,000 for research focused on environmental hazards that impact environmental justice communities.
