Opportunity Award: Climate Change and Human Health

- Basic science proposals on stress response
- · Climate modeling and health outcomes
- Community outreach and susceptibility
- Environmental exposures exacerbated by climate change

Focused Research Award:

Applicants can request up to \$50,000 for one year. Applications related to the CEET Thematic Areas are currently being accepted:

- Air Pollution and Lung Health
- Environmental Exposures and Cancer
- · Windows-of-Susceptibility
- Environmental Neuroscience
