

Culturally Aware Mentoring Workshops

The Workshops

- will provide practical strategies to enhance mentor skills in:
 - Fostering Mentee Belonging & Self-Efficacy
 - Providing Effective Feedback
 - Effective Communication: how to reveal the “hidden curriculum”, consider assumptions we may have, and approaches to validate unique identities of mentees

- Perelman School of Medicine Assistant, Associate and Full Professors actively mentoring or planning to mentor research trainees (predoctoral students and postdoctoral trainees).
- Non PSOM Faculty who mentor individuals appointed to T32 training grants
- Prior training is not a pre-requisite.
